Students in Levels 1-8 are required to enroll in and attend a minimum number of weekly classical ballet classes at NHB. Classes taken at other schools may not be substituted. This helps to ensure the proper development and safety of the students and allows for mastery of the material. The number of classical ballet classes per week required for students in the Student Division for levels 1, 2 and 3 are as follows:

Levels 2/3	2	3

For levels 2 and 3, participating in a weekly class that includes conditioning and stretch is highly recommended. Enrolling in enrichment classes can be a wonderful supplement to the development of a classical ballet dancer and is encouraged. Enrichment classes may not be substituted for classical ballet classes. New students and those who have missed a semester or more of classes at NHB are required to take a placement class before registering for classes.
