NEW HAVEN BALLET ACTIVITY EVACUATION

- **REMAIN CALM**
 - **FOLLOW DIRECTIONS FROM EMERGENCY PERSONNEL**
 - **USE STAIRWELLS** 
 - **DO NOT USE ELEVATORS** 
 - **FEEL THE DOOR BEFORE YOU OPEN IT AND NEVER OPEN A HOT DOOR**
 - **IF THERE IS SMOKE, DROP TO THE FLOOR AND CRAWL TO A SAFE LOCATION**
-  • Notify emergency response personnel (by calling 911) of any disabled persons requiring assistance and their location. Disabled individuals should proceed to the exit stairwell where emergency personnel will assist them with evacuation.

During an evacuation, you should also:

- Discontinue telephone conversations
- Leave all belongings behind
- Close all doors behind you
- Proceed to your designated assembly point which is:
 - Audubon: Leeney Plaza at 70 Audubon Street, New Haven
 - Whitney: Church of the Redeemer at 591 Whitney Avenue, New Haven
 - Shoreline: Adjacent parking lot at 200 Village Walk, Guilford
- Act calmly and courteously and help others if possible
