Studio COVID-19 Screening Questionnaire

By attending class in the studio, you are agreeing for yourself and minor children who are attending to New Haven Ballet's protocols, guidelines and policies, and reaffirming the following each time you or your child attends class in the studio. You agree to notify New Haven Ballet if answers to any of the following is YES:

1.	Have you had any signs or symptoms of a fever in the past 24 hours such as chills, sweats, felt "feverish" or had a temperature that is elevated for you or greater than 100.0F?	Yes	No
2.	Do you have any of the following symptoms? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cough • Shortness of breath or chest tightness • Sore throat • Nasal congestion/runny nose • Myalgia (body aches) • Loss of taste and/or smell • Diarrhea • Nausea • Vomiting • Fever/Chills/Sweats 	Yes	No
3.	Have you had close exposure with someone who has any of the above symptoms?	Yes	No
4.	Have you had close exposure with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19? ¹	Yes	No
5.	Have you tested positive for COVID-19? ²	Yes	No
6.	Have you been tested for COVID-19 and are awaiting results?	Yes	No
7.	Have you traveled to a high exposure location in the past 14 days?	Yes	No

If you have answered YES to any of the questions on this Screening Questionnaire you may not attend in person class until cleared ahead of time by New Haven Ballet.

¹ If you have had close exposure with someone who has symptoms of or has tested positive for COVID-19 you may not come to class for 14 days after exposure. Additionally you should stay home for 14 days after exposure based on the time it takes to develop illness.

² If you have tested positive for COVID-19, you may not return to class until (1) at least 3 days (72 hours) have passed since recovery defined as resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvement in respiratory symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath); and, (2) at least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared.
