## FINANCIAL AID SCHOLARSHIP GENERAL INFORMATION

New Haven Ballet provides a limited number of financial aid scholarships for eligible students aged 6 to 19 who exhibit both financial need and a strong dedication to the study of classical ballet at New Haven Ballet.

To be considered for a scholarship, applicants must:

- Complete and submit a financial aid application
- Provide required supporting documentation, including:
  - Proof of income, savings, and assets
  - Tax returns or other official proof of income
  - A student essay (or drawing for younger applicants)
  - Grade transcript

Students are considered for aid only after they have been evaluated and all application materials have been received. Applications are reviewed in the order they are submitted. To be eligible, all materials must be complete and submitted between **June 1 and August 1**. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

All financial information is kept strictly confidential.

Scholarships are made possible through the generous support of New Haven Ballet donors. Recipients must maintain excellent attendance in classes and rehearsals and are expected to serve as ambassadors for the Ballet in the community. This includes volunteering and helping to secure advertisements for performance programs.

Awards are granted to students who exhibit:

- Outstanding dedication to classical ballet training at New Haven Ballet
- The highest standards of moral and ethical behavior
- Kindness, courtesy, and graciousness in and out of the studio
- A clear commitment to the values and mission of the School
