## FINANCIAL AID

New Haven Ballet offers a limited number of financial aid scholarships to qualified dancers in the school, ages 5 to 19, who demonstrate a strong commitment to dance. Dancers with verified financial needs can apply to receive support from New Haven Ballet by completing an application and providing proof of income, savings, assets, and tax returns. Students will only be considered for financial aid scholarships after undergoing an evaluation and submitting their application along with all required documents, including an essay (or drawing) and tax filings or proof of income, by the specified application deadline. Applications and financial information are kept confidential.

Applications are evaluated, and awards are granted in the order they are submitted. You must submit your application materials promptly to be considered. Applications are accepted from June 1 to August 1 each year.

Financial aid is a special gift made possible through the generosity of New Haven Ballet donors. Financial aid recipients must demonstrate excellent class and rehearsal attendance. Students and their families are expected to serve as ambassadors of the Ballet in the greater community, volunteer their time, and assist with obtaining advertisements for performance program books.

Scholarships are awarded to deserving students who demonstrate remarkable dedication to studying classical ballet at New Haven Ballet, exhibit the highest moral and ethical standards, are kind, courteous, and gracious inside and outside the classroom, and show significant commitment to the School. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.
